

ORDINANCE 141

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING OF VEHICLES ON CERTAIN STREETS DURING SPECIFIC HOURS.

The City Council of the City of Bird Island do ordain as follows:

Section I. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation owning, operating, or controlling any vehicle within the City of Bird Island to park such vehicle upon the streets specified in Part A below between the hours of 2A.M. and 6 A.M.

- Part A.:
1. Main Street from the Chicago, Milwaukee, Saint Paul & Pacific Railroad tracks South to Birch Avenue.
 2. Highway Avenue from 6th Street West to 8th Street.
 3. Ash Avenue from 6th Street West to 8th Street.

SECTION II. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than (\$25.00) Twenty-five dollars, or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a period of not less than (10) ten days nor more than (90) ninety days.

SECTION III. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and the publication thereof.
