

**ORDINANCE 145**

**AN ORDINANCE CONTROLLING THE STORAGE OF ELM WOOD WITHIN  
THE CITY OF BIRD ISLAND.**

The Council does ordain:

Section I.: The storage of wood from American Elm trees without first removing all the bark from such wood, shall be prohibited within the city limits of Bird Island, Minnesota, between the dates of April 1<sup>st</sup> and September 15<sup>th</sup> each year.

Section II.: Violation of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor.

Section III.: This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and the publication thereof.
