

ORDINANCE 150

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE UNREASONABLE ACCELERATION
OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION
THEREOF.**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BIRD ISLAND, MINNESOTA, DOES
HEREBY ORDAIN:

Section 1. UNREASONABLE ACCELERATION: No person shall start or accelerate any motor vehicle with an unnecessary exhibition of speed on any public or private way within the City of Bird Island. Prima-facie evidence of such unnecessary exhibition of speed shall be squealing or screeching sounds emitted by the tires or the throwing of and or gravel by the tires of said vehicle; or the swerving of the rear or front of the vehicle from side to side.

Section 2. PENALTY: Any violation of this ordinance shall constitute a “petty misdemeanor” as defined in the Statutes of the State of Minnesota.
