

ORDINANCE 158

**AN ORDINANCE PLACING ADDITIONAL RESTRICTIONS OF THE
OPERATION OF AN ESTABLISHMENT OPERATING UNDER OUR
OFF-SALE LIQUOR LICENSE**

SECTION I. All holders of an Off-Sale License shall continue to be subject to all rules and regulations as set forth in the Minnesota Statutes and in Ordinance No. 54, plus amendments, of the City of Bird Island.

SECTION II. All holders of such an Off-Sale License within the City of Bird Island must comply with the following conditions:

- A. Good must be stored in a location separate from the bar, back bar, or any other place used to dispense On-Sale liquor by the drink.
- B. All Off-Sale purchases must be in the package form they were received in and wrapped in paper or placed in a paper bag immediately upon sale.
- C. Such packaged liquor must be removed from the establishment immediately after purchase and cannot be returned to an area where On-Sale liquor is being sold.
- D. The hours that liquor can be purchased by Off-Sale shall be 10 A.M. to 10 P.M. Monday through Saturday each week.

SECTION III. – Any person found guilty of violating any provision of this ordinance shall, at the discretion of the City Council, have his license revoked and shall forfeit any refund of the license fee.

SECTION IV. – If any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed to be in conflict with a provision of any other ordinance, such previous provisions shall be considered repealed and the provision of this ordinance shall be deemed to be in effect.

SECTION V. – This ordinance shall be in effect after passage by the council of the City of Bird Island and publication in the official newspaper of the city.
