

ORDINANCE NO. 161

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING HOURS FOR THE CLOSING OF
PREMISES LICENSED FOR THE SALE OF BEER, WINE AND
INTOXICATING LIQUORS.**

The City Council of the City of Bird Island ordains:

SECTION I. CONSUMPTION AFTER HOURS.

No person shall consume and no licensee shall permit the consumption of any non-intoxicating malt liquor, wine or intoxicating liquor on premises licensed for the sale thereof beginning 30 minutes after the sale of such beverages is prohibited under the law. All persons, except licensees and their employees, shall be off the premises of a licensee 30 minutes after the sale of such beverages is prohibited under the law.

SECTION II. PENALTY

Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor.

SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance becomes effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
