

**ORDINANCE 95**

**VILLAGE OF BIRD ISLAND, RENVILLE COUNTY, MINNESOTA**

**KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS; That**

WHEREAS the Village Council of the Village of Bird Island, Renville County, Minnesota, on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1970, passed and adopted Ordinance No. 95, entitled:

“AN ORDINANCE GRANTING PERMISSION OT NORTHERN STATES POWER COMPANY, A MINNESOTA CORPORATION, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, TO CONSTRUCT, OPERATE, REPAIR, AND MAINTAIN, IN THE VILLAGE OF BIRD ISLAND, MINNESOTA, AN ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM AND TRANSMISSION LINES, INCLUDING NECESSARY POLES, POLE LINES, AND FIXTURES AND APPURTENANCES, FOR THE FURNISHING OF ELECTRIC ENERGY TO THE VILLAGE AND ITS INHABITANTS, AND OTHERS, AND TRANSMITTING ELECTRIC ENERGY INTO AND THROUGH THE VILLAGE AN TO USE THE STREETS, ALLEYS AND PUBLIC GROUNDS OF SAID VILLAGE FOR SUCH PURPOSES”

which Ordinance was duly published according to law on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1970, in BIRD ISLAND UNION, a newspaper printed and published in the Village of Bird Island, Renville County, Minnesota, and of general circulation in said Village of Bird Island and County of Renville and State of Minnesota;

NOW THEREFORE, Northern States Power Company, a Minnesota corporation, for itself and its successors and assigns, does hereby accept all the terms and conditions of said Ordinance.
