

**ORDINANCE 99**

**VILLAGE OF BIRD ISLAND**

An ordinance Enacting the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Title 169 (highways, roads) as amended to date as and for a street, Highways and Traffic Code as and for the Village of Bird Island, to be know as Ordinance Number 169 and to subdivided into Sections 169.01 through 169.99.

The Village Council of the Village of Bird Island, Renville County, Minnesota, ordains that the provisions of Chapter 169 of the Minnesota Statutes (Highways, Roads) as the same are in force and as amended at the effective date of the enactment of this Ordinance, are hereby enacted into law as Ordinance of the Village of Bird Island, and the same are hereby incorporated herein by reference into sections, 169.01 through 169.99.

Violations of any section of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or by incarceration in jail for not to exceed Ninety (90) days, or both.

Passed by the Village Council of the Village of Bird Island, by unanimous vote, at a regular meeting of said council on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1972, with effective date to be July 1, 1972, upon confirmation by the Village Council following a public hearing to be held at the Village Hall on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of June, 1972, at 8:00 P.M.
