

ORDINANCE 51

An ordinance prohibiting the sale and shooting off of fire-crackers, fire works and other explosives within the platted portion of the Village of Bird Island, Minnesota, and of creating loud and disturbing noises, which disturb the peace and quiet of the said Village of Bird Island, and of prescribing penalties for the violation thereof, on all days of the year, except the 4th day of each July in each year hereafter, in so far as said ordinance pertains to shooting off said explosives, and except the 3rd and 4th days of July of each year, so far as the sale of explosives is concerned. The Village Council of the Village of Bird Island, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

SECTION I

On and after the adoption and publication of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to sell, or in any manner dispose of within the Village of Bird Island, Minnesota, any fire crackers of any description, fire works, or any kind of explosives that make a loud and disturbing noise, at any time of the day or night, except the 3rd and 4th days of July, of each year hereafter, and except and unless the sale thereof is expressly permitted and authorized by the Village Council of said Village of Bird Island.

SECTION II

On and after the adoption and publication of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to shoot or set off any fire-crackers of any description, fire-works, or any kind of an explosive that makes a loud and disturbing noise, within the platted portion of the said Village of Bird Island, or to shoot off, or explode any fire-crackers, fire-works, or any kind of explosives, or rockets from an automobile while in motion within the platted portion of said Village of Bird Island at any time of the day or night, except on the 4th day of July, between the hours of 5:00 o'clock A.M. and midnight of said day of each year from the passage of this ordinance, unless a special permit is procured from the Village Council of said Village of Bird Island, so to do upon special occasions.

SECTION III

Any person or persons who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction of said violation be subject to the payment of a fine of not less than \$5.00, nor more than \$50.00, an in default of the payment of such fine to stand committed to the common jail of Renville County, Minnesota, for not less than five (5) and more than forty (40) days.

SECTION IV

All ordinances and parts of ordinances adopted prior hereto and which are in consistence herewith, are hereby repealed.
