

ORDINANCE 57.5

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION (4) FOUR, ORDINANCE NO. 55, OF THE VILLAGE OF BIRD ISLAND, COUNTY OF RENVILLE, STATE OF MINNESOTA, RELATING TO AN ORDINANCE LICENSING AND REGULATING THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR

The Village Council of the Village of Bird Island do hereby ordain:

Section 1. Fees. The Section Four (4), Ordinance No. 55 of the Village of Bird Island be, and the same is hereby Amended so as to read as follows:

All applications for licenses shall be accompanied by a receipt from the Village Treasurer for the required annual fees for respective licenses. All such fees shall be paid into the general fund of the Village. Upon rejection of any application for a license, the Village Treasurer shall refund the amount paid, and the bond of the applicant shall be returned to him. The annual fee for "On Sale" license shall be Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars. The annual fee for an "Off Sale" shall be One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars. Where such licenses are issued for less than one year, the fee therefore shall be a prorate share of the annual fee.
