

**ORDINANCE 57**

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF CERTAIN VEHICLES ON AND ALONG CERTAIN STREETS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF BIRD ISLAND, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES THEREOF**

The Village Council of Bird Island do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation owning, operating or controlling any vehicle used for the purpose of selling, vending or distributing any goods, wares, merchandise, farm products or any article offered for sale to the public at retail, to park the said vehicle for the purpose of sale of said goods on any of the following described streets within the Village of Bird Island, as follows, to-wit:

1. The whole of Main Street beginning at the Chicago, Milwaukee, Saint Paul and Pacific Railroad tracks, south to "A" Street.
2. The whole of "H" Street, commonly known as State Trunk Highway No. 212, beginning with Maple Street and ending with Sixth Avenue.
3. The whole of Maple Street, beginning at the northerly end of said street and extending south to "F" Street.
4. The whole of Sixth Avenue, beginning with State Trunk Highway No. 212 and ending at "F" Street.
5. That part of "F" Street, beginning at Sixth Avenue and ending at Maple Street.
6. That part of "D" Street beginning with Main Street and ending at Maple Street.
7. That part of Maple Street beginning at "D" Street and ending at "C" Street.
8. That part of "C" Street beginning with Main Street and ending with Maple Street.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Act upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars, nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not less than ten (10) days nor more than ninety (90) days.

Section 3. This Act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication thereof.
