

ORDINANCE 57A

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION TWO (2), PARAGRAPH "A", ORDINANCE NO. 52, OR
THE VILLAGE OF BIRD ISLAND, COUNTY OF RENVILLE, STATE OF MINNESOTA,
RELATING TO AN ORDINANCE LICENSING AND REGULATING THE SALE OF NON-
INTOXICATING MALT LIQUORS**

The Village Council of the Village of Bird Island do hereby ordain:

Section 1. License Required. The Section Two (2), paragraph "A", Ordinance No. 52 of the Village of Bird Island, be, and the same is hereby, Amended to read as follows:

"On Sale" License shall be granted only to drug stores, cafes, restaurants, hotels, and bona fide clubs, and shall permit the sale of such non-intoxicating malt liquors for consumption on the premises only; and the License Fee therefore shall be Forty-five (\$45.00) Dollars per annum.
