

ORDINANCE 74

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 2B AND 2D OF ORDINANCE NO. 66 OF THE VILLAGE OF BIRD ISLAND, RENVILLE COUNTY, MINNESOTA, RELATING TO AN ORDINANCE LICENSING AND REGULATING GAMES OF SKILL**

The Village Council of the Village of Bird Island do hereby ordain:

That Sections 2B and 2D of Ordinance No. 66 of the Village of Bird Island, enacted on June 3, 1943, be, and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 2B. A semi-annual license fee of Twelve and 50/100 (\$12.50) Dollars for every particular piece of equipment or device shall accompany each application, which amount shall be put into the General Fund of the municipality. The license period shall be from January 1<sup>st</sup> to June 30<sup>th</sup> and from July 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup> of each year. Said semi-annual license fee shall be retro-active as to start as of July 1, 1947.

Section 2D. In the event of the installation of a new piece of equipment or device within ninety (90) days prior to the expiration of any licensing period, the license fee shall be Two and 10/100 (\$2.10) Dollars per month, or any fractional part thereof.
