

**ORDINANCE 80**

KNOWN ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Whereas the Village Council of the Village of Bird Island, Minnesota did on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of February 1953, A.D. pass, adopt and approve an Ordinance designated as Ordinance No. 80, which Ordinance is entitled;

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BIRD ISLAND, RENVILLE COUNTY, MINNESOTA, GRANTING TO THE MINNESOTA VALLEY NATURAL GAS COMPANY, A MINNESOTA CORPORATION, ITS LESSEES, SUCCESSORS, AND ASSIGNS, A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE TO OPERATE A GAS SYSTEM WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF BIRD ISLAND AND TO SUPPLY GAS TO THE INHABITANTS THEREOF, AND TO OTHERWISE REGULATE SUCH BUSINESS OPERATIOIS**

and whereas the said Ordinance has been duly enacted according to law and is now in full force and effect.

Now, THEREFORE, the Minnesota Valley Natural Gas Company, a Minnesota Corporation, for itself and its successors and assigns does hereby accept the above entitled Ordinance and all the terms and conditions thereof, and does hereby agree with the said Village of Bird Island, that it or its successors in interest will at no time institute legal proceedings to question the validity of said entitled Ordinance, or the right and power of the Village Council of the Village of Bird Island to enact said Ordinance.
