

**ORDINANCE 89**

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF THE VILLAGE RUBBISH DUMP**

The Village Council of Bird Island ordains:

Section 1. THE NEED OF PERMITS.

- a. All persons using the dump owned and operated by the Village of Bird Island shall obtain a permit to do so from the office of the Clerk of the Village.
- b. Such a permit shall cost \$1.00.

Section 2. HOURS DUMP IS TO BE OPEN.

- a. Dumping shall be allowed only between the hours specified by the Council and posted at the dump grounds.
- b. Permission to use the dump at other than the specified hours shall be granted by the Clerk and carry a time limit.

Section 3. RESTRICTED MATERIAL. The following material shall not be place in the Village dump:

- a. Automobile bodies, frames and engines.
- b. Large metal household appliances.
- c. Fieldstone and farm fencing.

Section 4. BURNING.

- a. All paper, cardboard and other combustable material shall be ignited before leaving the dump area.

Section 5. ELIGIBILITY OF PATRONS.

- a. All residents of Bird Island Village and rural Bird Island patrons from the surrounding area.

Section 6. PENALTY. Any person violating any section of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to a fine not to exceed One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and costs or confinement in the County jail for a period not to exceed Ninety (90) days.

Section 7. This ordinance shall be in full effect after passage by the Village Council of the Village of Bird Island and its publication according to law.
