

ORDINANCE 90

AN ORDINANCE TO LIMIT AND REGULATE THE KEEPING OF BEES

The Village Council of the Village of Bird Island do ordain as follows:

Section 1.

BEEKEEPING LIMITED. No person shall keep any bees within the Village of Bird Island on property owned or controlled by him within one thousand (1,000) feet of the property line of any other property owner. Bees kept contrary to this ordinance are hereby declared a public nuisance and may be abated according to law.

Section 2.

PENALTY. Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and costs, or by imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days.

Section 3.

REPEAL. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4.

EFFECT. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after May 24, 1968.
