ORDINANCE 91

ESTABLISHING THE CHARGES FOR CONNECTING A PRIVATE WATER SERVICE TO THE VILLAGE WATER MAINS

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF BIRD ISLAND, MINNESOTA, DOES ORDAIN:

The charge to each property owner to attach a private water service to the Village water main to receive water from the Village supply shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00).

FURTHER: Such property owner shall pay the Village for a water meter and its installation.

FURTHER: For this fee, the Village shall furnish a curb stop and maintain that portion of the private service from the curb stop to the Village main after such private service is installed, providing this service line is of copper.

FURTHER: Each property owner shall pay for all costs of digging, pipe or tubing, fittings, installation, back filling and other costs incidental to such installation from the Village water main to the meter except that the Village employees shall do the actual connection to the water main.
