

ORDINANCE 92

AN ORDINANCE AMMENDING PARTS OF ORDINANCES #65, #76 AND #84 DESCRIBING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ADMINISTRATION OF MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM.

The Village Council of the Village of Bird Island do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 12 of Ordinance #65 dated December 3, 1942, relating to time of meter readings is hereby amended to read:

All water meters installed in the Village of Bird Island shall be read annually. Such annual reading shall take place on or before July 1 of each year and shall constitute the basis for determining the charges for such twelve months period.

Section 2. Section 1 of the Ordinance #84 dated January 21, 1960, which amended section 6 of Ordinance #76 relating to charges for water service in the Village of Bird Island is hereby amended to read:

- a. Water supplied to regular customers shall be measured by a meter and the following schedule shall apply.

(Minimum - \$12.00 per year)

0 to 20 M @ \$0.75 = \$15.00 20M

20 to 100M @ \$0.50 = \$40.00 80M

100 to 600M @ \$0.20 = \$100.00 500M

600 to -0-M @ \$0.15 =

- b. The Village Council shall determine the flat rate charge to be paid by occasional or special customer.

c. The minimum water bill shall be (\$12.00) Twelve Dollars per year except when service is begun or terminated within a year at which time the minimum charge shall be pro-rated for that portion of a year water was provided

d. Customers will be billed quarterly for the first three quarters of the billing period; such charge to be one-fourth of the preceeding annual charge for that meter for each quarter. Further, the fourth quarter billing shall be for water used for the year, based on the annual meter reading less credit for that amount received from the customer for the preceeding three quarters of the annual billing period.

Section 3.

The effective date of this Ordinance shall be July 1, 1969.
